# STUDENT AND TRAINEE ASSOCIATION FOR SEXUAL HEALTH AND HIV (STASHH)





**EDUCATION**: For medical students and pre-speciality trainees relating to Sexual Health and HIV medicine, including revision sessions and specialty workshops.




**CAREERS**: Increase visibility and awareness of the specialty through recruitment events, promotion of national recruitment resources and engagement with training programme directors.


